



FAQ

How can this program be incorporated into the curriculum/department?

Our different plans are meant to provide a variety of options for the districts. The 5 day plan, for example, would include all the components of teaching, including development of assessments and grading. The other plans are meant to augment the teaching power of your district. We will collaborate with your in-person teachers to support the classroom goals. Our program can also be used as an extra-curricular activity to support student learning.

What will the district need to provide in order to use the program?

To make it easy for students to adapt to our program, we will use your online conference app. We will ask that you provide login credentials for the teaching team. If our team is in charge of grading, we will need access to your grading platform.

Students will need access to a device to connect to our classes and a set of headphones with microphone to participate in the sessions.

Rather than using books or pre-printed materials, our program provides a curated selection of websites for students to practice and develop language and cultural skills.

Why should we choose this program?

Because this program uses virtual tools to connect students with authentic learning. Our highly qualified teachers live in South America, and that allows them to infuse their teaching with all kinds of cultural assets that are not possible in other settings.

Additionally, students in our program interact with multiple teachers and language leaders and this allows them to develop confidence and fluidity. This also creates an environment that fosters curiosity, critical thinking, communications skills, and global awareness.
